

GUIDE ON ACCESING THE ORGANISED GAS MARKET

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1. INTRODUCTION

This Guide on Accessing the Organised Gas Market describes the steps to be taken for acquiring the status of Agent, or Delegated Entity, in the Organised Gas Market.

In addition, for the purpose of drafting a standardised set of documents to facilitate their consultation and avoid delays in the processes to be undertaken before the Market Operator, a series of models have been provided as Annexes that include, amongst others, the types of powers of attorney and the authorisations to be granted by the Agents in the Market.

2. ACQUIRING THE STATUS OF AGENT

As laid down in the Rules on the Organised Gas Market, an Agent is any legal entity that having acquired the status of Authorised Party and subscribed the Adhesion Contract, and fulfilled the requirements set forth in those Rules, is entitled to trade in the market.

The status of Agent involves fulfilling the following requirements:

- Have previously acquired the status of Authorised Party in the Spanish or Portuguese systems, or in both, as granted by the Technical Managers.
- Have previously acquired the status of Guarantees Account User in the Guarantees Manager and have sufficient guarantees in the Market Assignment Account.
- Have expressly adhered to the rules and conditions on operation and settlement through the subscription of the corresponding Adhesion Contract (in order to negotiate products with delivery in the PVB or in the VTP).
- Have undergone the required technical qualification tests.
- Have provided the sundry operation data associated to their involvement in the market, as well as all the necessary information for the processes of invoicing, guarantees, and collections and payments, as described in this guide.

This last requirement shall be mainly through an electronic procedure that basically consists of two stages:

1. The first stage is undertaken through the MIBGAS public website (<http://www.mibgas.es>), by submitting the required data on a form, which is to provide the general details on an applicant seeking to acquire the status of Agent.
2. The second stage is undertaken through the Registry and Queries Platform (<https://www.market.mibgas.es>), which is accessed solely by means of an electronic certificate, which requires detailed information from the applicant for its participation in the market. This second stage involves several parallel processes in which an applicant is informed electronically of its progress in each one of them.

Some of the steps in this electronic procedure require the delivery of additional documents on paper.

3. MARKET ADHESION PROCEDURE FOR AGENTS

3.1 Acquiring the status of Authorised Party

At the same time as the start of the procedures before the Market Operator, steps are to be taken to obtain the status of Authorised Party in the Spanish or Portuguese systems, or in both, before the Technical Manager of the Spanish Gas System (hereinafter “GTS”) or the Global Technical Manager of the Portuguese Gas System (hereinafter “GTG”).

Specifically, those Agents who wish to operate in the Virtual Balance Point (PVB) must be authorized by the Spanish GTS (Enagás GTS), and those agents who wish to operate in the Virtual Trading Point (VTP) must be authorized by the Portuguese GTG (REN Gasodutos).

Those Agents that acquire the status of Authorised Party exclusively in either the Spanish or Portuguese systems may only trade in products with delivery in the Spanish or Portuguese systems, respectively.

The procedure for obtaining the status of Authorised Party may be undertaken in parallel to the procedures required for acquiring the status of Agent, with the former step being a pre-requisite for completing the registration process as an Agent.

3.2 OMIClear authorisation

Those MIBGAS Agents interested in trading the Balance of Month and Month Ahead products must obtain the authorisation from OMIClear. To communicate to OMIClear their interest in trading these products, please address the following contacts:

- › Marketing department: marketing@omiclear.pt
- › Clearing department: clearing@omiclear.pt

Only those Agents authorised by OMIClear may trade these products, and therefore, if OMIClear communicates to MIBGAS the loss of the mentioned authorisation, MIBGAS will proceed to disable the Agent to trade these products.

3.3 Submitting general information via the public website

In order to launch the required process for adhering to the market, an applicant is to complete the Agent Registration form, which is available on the MIBGAS public website (<http://www.mibgas.es>).

All the fields marked as required are to be completed on that form.

These fields are:

Company data

- › Company name
- › Tax Number (*Código de Identificación Fiscal* in Spanish)
- › Energy Identification Code (EIC)

Attorney's data

- › Name
- › Surname
- › Second surname (optional)
- › ID/Passport
- › Contact phone number
- › Mobile phone (optional)
- › Contact e-mail

Registration profile, with the following options:

- › Market Agent: for registration, not only as Guarantees Account User in the Guarantees Manager, but also for the participation in the Organized Gas Market.
- › Guarantees Account User: for registration exclusively as a Guarantees Account User in the Guarantees Manager.

When selecting the “Market Agent” option, the “Guarantees Account User” option will be automatically selected as it is required parallel registration processing.

Manner of operation in the market, with the following options:

- › Agent: When the Agent acts in its own name, being entitled in turn to act on behalf of other Agents.
- › Delegated Entity: A legal entity that is not an Agent and which will act in the name of a delegating agent.
- › Delegating Agent: When the Agent acts through a delegated legal entity.

Data for delivering the certificate:

- › E-mail for delivering the software certificate
- › E-mail for delivering the PIN for the software certificate

Once completed, click on the button *Send Application*

Besides completing the form, each applicant is to send MIBGAS the following documents on paper:

- › Copy of the document that specifies the tax number (*Número de Identificación Fiscal - NIF*) of the entity applying to become a market Agent, issued by the Tax Authorities (Agencia Tributaria in Spain).
- › Copy of the identity card or passport of the signatory of the application, who is to have sufficient powers to perform all those acts and sign all those documents required for the full adhesion to the Market of the applicant, or their clients.
- › A power of attorney duly notarised and legalised for the person acting on the entity's behalf that is to contain sufficient powers to perform all those acts and sign all those documents required for the full adhesion to the Organised Gas Market of the applicant, or their clients. These powers shall be valid for MIBGAS if they involve:
 - Powers according to the content featured in this guide (Model I in Annex I).
 - General and sufficient powers of attorney, with no limit on their scope and granted on a joint and several basis.

Model I in Annex I to this document provides a template of the deed that may be used for the powers of attorney granted by an applicant entity.

In addition, **Model II** in Annex I is a form that needs to be submitted in the event of delegation.

These powers, although they need to be submitted as a photocopy, may be sent beforehand in PDF format to the following e-mail address agentes@mibgas.es, for their official acceptance as fit for purpose.

Once the documents have been presented and accepted, MIBGAS shall proceed to generate a personal electronic certificate for access to Market Platform, in the name of the person who has been authorised to conduct the administrative procedures. This certificate shall be provided on a software format.

This software certificate shall be sent together with the items and information required for its use, to the address specified on the form, to the attention of the corresponding Attorney. At the same time as the software certificate is sent, an e-mail shall be delivered with the password for downloading the software certificate (PIN) to the e-mail address specified on the form.

3.4 Acquisition of the Status of Guarantees Account User

As laid down in the Rules of the Organised Gas Market, Market Agents should have previously acquired the status of Guarantees Account User.

Regardless of whether the Agent wishes to negotiate products with delivery in the PVB, the VTP or both, it must acquire the status of Guarantee Account User.

The registration process as a Guarantees Account User is described in the Guide on Accessing the Guarantees Manager, which is available at MIBGAS public website (www.mibgas.es > Guarantee Manager > Become a Guarantee Account User).

When the attorney power provided to be registered as a Guarantees Account User is acceptable to be registered as a Market Agent, the electronic certificate of the attorney person will be enabled to access both the Guarantees Management Platform and the Registration and Consultations Platform (both accessible through <https://www.market.mibgas.es>).

The powers included in this guide as Appendix I shall be valid for the acquisition of the Guarantees Account User status.

If the attorney powers submitted are the special powers included in Appendix I of the Guide on Accessing the Guarantees Manager, these shall not be sufficient to acquire the status of Market Agent. In this case, it is convenient to proceed to the simultaneously submission of both templates.

The information provided by the subject to be registered as a Guarantees Account User or as a Market Agent shall be common to the Market Operator and the Guarantees Manager and it shall be accessible both from the Market Platform and the Guarantees Management Platform. Therefore, once submitted through one platform, it is not necessary to be submitted through the other.

The process of acquiring the Guarantees Account User status can be performed in parallel with the process required to obtain the Market Agent status. The completion of the registration process as Guarantees Account User is an indispensable requirement to complete the registration process as Market Agent.

3.5 Delivery of detailed information via the Registry and Queries Platform

After receiving the electronic certificate, and in order to provide MIBGAS with all the data associated to participation in the market, use is to be made of the Registry and Queries Platform, which is accessible from the MIBGAS website for Market Agents (<https://www.market.mibgas.es>).

In order to securely insert or modify the associated data, **a software certificate with an update or attorney's profile is required to access this system (section 5.5)**. MIBGAS shall issue certificates with an attorney's profile, provided that the corresponding application is accompanied by powers of attorney that fulfil the same conditions as those required for obtaining the status of Agent in the Organised Gas Market.

The following are the data that need to be inserted via the Registry and Queries Platform:

- › General information on the Agent: company name, tax number or equivalent, registered address, EIC and type of Agent.

If this information has already been provided in the Guarantees Management Platform for the registration process as a Guarantees Account User, it shall be necessary to complete it with the "Agent type" information.

Participant data > Modify reference data > Basic details

- › Contact persons with the Market Operator, with contact phone numbers and e-mail addresses.

Participants data > Modify reference data > Contact persons

- › Users authorised to access the Market Platform, with specification of the permissions granted.

Participant data > Modify reference data > Contact persons

- › Trading Portfolios.

Participant data > Modify reference data > Trading Portfolio: New

- › Bank Account, with its corresponding detail.

Participant data > Modify reference data > Bank account

- › Likewise, the Agent may impose limits on the posting of orders for the different products, with the aim being to avoid errors. For each product, the Agent may introduce the jump in price and the maximum amount permitted in its orders. If it does not specify a limit, application shall be made of the limits the system defines by default, as stipulated in the corresponding Market Resolution.

Participant data > Modify reference data > Order limits: Edit

- › Generation of the Adhesion Contract: It is to be generated within the Registry and Queries Platform by using the Adhesion Contract software certificate.

An Agent may not generate its Adhesion Contract until its basic information has been processed.

Participant data > Adhesion contract > MIBGAS adhesion contract - ES.

Participant data > Adhesion contract > MIBGAS adhesion contract - PT.

This shall lead to the creation of a PDF file that contains the Adhesion Contract to negotiate products with delivery in the PVB or in the VTP, as appropriate, whereby two copies of the file are to be printed and all its pages endorsed. Once both copies have been signed, they are to be sent to MIBGAS for its signature. One of the original copies shall then be returned to the applicant, with the other remaining in the possession of MIBGAS. The subscription of the Adhesion Contract “per se” does not mean that the status of Agent has been granted, as it is simply another requirement to be fulfilled during the process of accessing the market.

Note that for the negotiation of products in PVB and VTP, the Agent must generate and sign both adhesion contracts. For the Contract of Adhesion to the Rules of the Spanish Market, the binding version will be the Spanish; while for the Contract of Adhesion to the Portuguese Market Rules it will be the Portuguese one.

The signing of the aforementioned contracts may also be done through a digital signature.

In this case, the signature must be such that it can be validated through the Valid-e application, at the following link, or another official application for certificates issued by certification bodies in the European Union: <https://validate.redsara.es/valide/validarFirma/ejecutar.html>

The electronically signed contract will be sent by email to agentes@mibgas.es. From MIBGAS it will be signed, and it will be sent by email to the address available on the platform for this purpose.

- › Generation of the REMIT data Provision Agreement: the generation of the REMIT data Provision Agreement is to be requested within the Registry and Queries Platform by using the software certificate.

An Agent may not generate its REMIT data Provision Agreement until its basic information has been processed.

Participant data > REMIT > MIBGAS. Reporting Service: New.

After validating the request, the agreement will be generated and sent to the Contact e-mail specified on the application form, whereby two copies of the file are to be printed and all its pages endorsed. Once both copies have been signed, they are to be sent to MIBGAS for its signature. One of the original copies shall then be returned to the applicant, with the other remaining in the possession of MIBGAS.

The signing of the aforementioned contract may also be done through a digital signature.

In this case, the signature must be such that it can be validated through the Valid-e application, at the following link, or another official application for certificates issued by certification bodies in the European Union: <https://validate.redsara.es/valide/validarFirma/ejecutar.html>

The electronically signed contract will be sent by email to agentes@mibgas.es. From MIBGAS it will be signed, and it will be sent by email to the address available on the platform for this purpose.

This service has a cost that is detailed in the Fees Instruction, available in the [Legislation](#) section of the MIBGAS public website.

The obligation to report REMIT data is detailed in section 5.8 of this Guide.

3.6 Technical qualification

Annex II describes the procedure to be followed for obtaining technical qualification, in which a check shall be made to ensure that the Agents' IT systems are properly set up and that the personnel receiving that qualification have the necessary understanding of the Market Platform to take part in it.

At the end of the procedure described for obtaining technical qualification, the Agent is to send MIBGAS a hardcopy of Annex II to this guide, duly completed, including the certificate provided for in point 6, which is to be signed by the person empowered to oversee the Agent's registration process.

The signing of the document may also be done through a digital signature.

In this case, the signature must be such that it can be validated through the Valid-e application, at the following link, or another official application for certificates issued by certification bodies in the European Union:

The electronically signed contract will be sent by email to agentes@mibgas.es.

3.7 Access procedure for a Delegating Agent through the figure of a representative in the form of a legal entity

When proceeding through the figure of a representative in the form of a legal entity (either through another Agent or a Delegate) application shall be made of the procedure described in the preceding points, with the following additional requirements:

- › Said Delegate is to accredit its status by presenting the corresponding powers of attorney (**Model II** in Annex I).
- › In addition, it shall register such delegation through the Registry and Queries Platform.
- › *Participants data > Register status > Representation: General register status > Represented (access is by right-clicking on the delegate's record).*
- › The Delegate shall provide all those documents required by the Market Operator for the purpose of empowering it to proceed in that capacity.

The Delegating Agent shall accept full responsibility for all the Delegate's actions in the market.

3.8 Procedure for the declaration of formation of Business Group

The Trading Platform will have an optional mechanism that will prevent the matching of orders sent for trading in the Continuous Market between Agents who declare that they belong to the same Business Group, as defined in Article 42.1 of the Commercial Code. Agents wishing to use this mechanism must present a Declaration on belonging to a Business Group in accordance with **Model III** provided in Annex I.

3.9 Completion of the access process

Once all the information received via the electronic forms has been verified, and likewise the documents on paper have also been received and verified, MIBGAS shall declare the process completed, with granting of the status of Agent.

For the completion of the registration process as an Agent, this must have acquired the status of Guarantees Account User. Also, the Market Operator must have received the applicant's suitability by at least one of the Technical Managers.

4. ACQUIRING THE STATUS OF DELEGATED ENTITY

A Delegated Entity is a legal entity that acts as a Delegate for Agents on the Organised Gas Market without being an Agent.

Those parties that wish to acquire the status of Delegated Entity are to complete the access form on the public website described in 3.2., specifying this option.

Once the Delegated Entity has received the software certificate, it is to provide the following data through the Registry and Queries Platform:

- ▶ General data on the entity: company name, tax number or equivalent, and registered address.

Participants data > Modify reference data > Basic details

- ▶ Contact persons with the Market Operator, with contact phone numbers and e-mail addresses.

Participants data > Modify reference data > Contact persons

- ▶ Users authorised to access the Market Platform, with specification of the permissions granted.

Participants data > Security certificates maintenance > New certificate

- ▶ Whatsoever other information as required for the proper pursuit of its operations in the market.

Once all the information received via the electronic forms has been verified, and likewise the documents on paper have also been received and verified, MIBGAS shall declare the process completed, with granting of the status of Delegated Entity.

5. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

5.1 Sharing information with MIBGAS

As described in the preceding chapter, the information to be shared with MIBGAS during the adhesion process and the provision of the data associated to participation in the market shall be delivered through the Registry and Queries Platform. In addition to this Access Guide, the application has help manuals for facilitating the introduction of data.

5.3 IT Systems

The MIBGAS public website contains the “Workstation Setup Guide for Accessing the MIBGAS Platform” which describes the requirements a client workstation needs to fulfil for logging onto the Organised Gas Market Platform, as well as the necessary steps to be taken to properly set up and begin using the Registry and Queries Platform and the Trading Platform.

The main tools required for using the Organised Gas Market Platform website, whose required specifications and versions are listed in the Guide, are as follows:

- Hardware: PC or laptop, with suitable processing and memory specifications
- Windows Operating System
- Microsoft Edge browser
- Java Virtual Machine (32 bits)
- Digital certificates

5.4 Software and Documents for Accessing the Market Agents Website

Once the application for registering as an Agent has been submitted through the public website, and when an access certificate has been requested for the company's Attorney, MIBGAS shall provide the prospective Agent with the necessary means for downloading the certificate.

Access is also to be provided to the website with the necessary documents and software for installing and setting up the workstation for accessing the Market Agents Website.

5.5 Process for requesting additional certificates

Additional certificates may be requested for operating in the Organised Gas Market.

In order to request these certificates, and provided that the model of Powers of Attorney contained in this Access Guide has been used, all that is needed for their issue is a simple written request or an electronic request from the Attorney.

When the powers used for registering the Agent in the Organised Gas Market are not those provided in this Guide, the requests for software certificates are to be accompanied by powers of attorney that authorise the applicants to operate in this market.

In the application for additional certificates, the following profiles can be distinguished:

» Registration and Consultations Platform:

- » "No Access" profile: does not allow access to the Registry and Queries Platform.
- » "Update" profile: allows the access and modification of the Agent's information in the Registry and Queries Platform, except for the modification of the bank account and the management of certificates, which can only be done if the certificate is also an attorney certificate.
- » "Query" profile: allows access to the Registry and Queries Platform, but not allows the modification of the Agent's information.

» Trading Platform:

- » "No access" profile: does not allow access to the Trading Platform.
- » "Update" profile: allows the access and the sending, modification and cancellation of offers in the Trading Platform.
- » "Query" profile: allows access to the Trading Platform, but does not allow the sending, modification and cancellation of offers.

Participant data > Security Certificate Maintenance > New certificate

5.6 Guarantees

As part of the Agent registration process, initial guarantees established in the "Types and calculation of guarantee requirements" section of the "Economic results, invoicing, collections and payments and guarantees managed by MIBGAS" Rule must be formalised.

Likewise, Agents should provide sufficient guarantees to cover their operations in the market.

Guarantees must be formalised in favor of the Guarantees Manager according to the Rules for Managing Guarantees in the Gas System, as described in the Guide on Accessing the Guarantees Manager, which is available at MIBGAS public website (www.mibgas.es > Guarantee Manager > Become a Guarantee Account User).

5.7 Telephone assistance during trading

5.8 REMIT

Pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2024/1106 of 11 April 2024, which modifies Regulation (EU) 1227/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council on wholesale energy market integrity and transparency (hereinafter “REMIT”), the participants in those markets are required to regularly report the Agency for the Cooperation of Energy Regulators (hereinafter “ACER”) with operations carried out on wholesale energy markets.

According to the provisions of Article 6 of Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No. 1348/2014 of 17 December 2014 on data reporting implementing Article 8(2) and Article 8(6) of Regulation (EU) No. 1227/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council on wholesale energy market integrity and transparency, the organised market place where the wholesale energy product was executed or the order was placed shall at the request of the market participant offer a data reporting agreement.

Pursuant to the above, MIBGAS, as the entity responsible for managing the Organised Gas Market, renders a reporting service by virtue of the aforementioned EU Regulation as Registered Reporting Mechanism (RRM) of ACER.

In order to comply the aforementioned obligations, it will be necessary for the Agent to provide MIBGAS with its ACER code (and keep it updated at all times) and to sign the REMIT data Provision Agreement for the daily reporting of all its operations carried out on the Market Platform to ACER, following the steps detailed in section 3.5.

Compliance with European and national regulation is an essential requirement for access to and participation in the Organised Gas Market. Non-compliance may result in penalties that will be passed on to the participant as the party ultimately responsible for its activity.

6. AGENT DEREGISTRATION PROCESS

Before proceeding with the withdrawal, the Market Operator will ensure that the Agent has closed all its positions in the market and met satisfied all its collection and payment commitments with the market.

The deregistration procedure is carried out through the Registration and Queries Platform, editing the termination date in MIBGAS:

Participant data > Modifying reference data > Basic information

Once the previous step has been completed, MIBGAS will request the release of the initial guarantee deposited in the market activity as soon as possible and the agent will be notified.

7. MODELS

The templates are presented forthwith, with the rules on their completion being as follows:

- › The texts in italics between brackets are not to appear in the final document.
- › The texts in italics without brackets are to be replaced by the appropriate value with no highlighting.

POWERS

1. For accessing the Organised Gas Market:
 - 1.1 To appear before whatsoever pertinent public or private agencies, and especially before the Market Operator and before the Technical Manager to undertake whatsoever administrative procedures as may be required or deemed convenient for requesting the necessary permissions, communications and documents for the purpose of accessing the Organised Gas Market.
 - 1.2 Subscribing the adhesion contract and whatsoever other kinds of documents as necessary and deemed convenient for full adhesion to the Organised Gas Market, and undertake whatsoever acts as necessary or deemed convenient accordingly.
2. For participating in the Organised Gas Market and operating in the gas system, both before the Market Operator and before the Technical Manager:
 - 2.1 Formalise, according to the terms and conditions deemed appropriate, whatsoever purchase and sales orders for the different products in the Organised Gas Market and for operating in the gas system.
